Canada's Literary Music Man

Born in Penzance, Cornwall England. Resident in Canada since the 1960s, Martin Melhuish has been one of the most literate, productive music journalists and authors writing about musicians for more than 40 years, his books ranging from a definitive biography of Bachman-Turner Overdrive to a colourful and instructive history of Celtic music and a series of books that spin stories about the early years in Canadian music, chronicling achievements that in many cases have been overlooked and untold.

Martin is a respected music historian whose histories have been the basis for a number of television documentaries, radio shows and album compilations. Martin has authored more than a dozen music-related books. He holds international multimedia experience in the fields of music, entertainment and popular culture as a TV producer/director/writer, radio producer/writer, author, journalist, magazine editor and music historian.




