
<u>Creemore Nature Preserve – Mingay Trail 3.7 km</u>

<u>Directions</u>: Leave Collingwood going east on Beechwood Road (old road to Wasaga Beach). Turn right on Fairgrounds road, and follow it to Creemore. As one is approaching Creemore, turn right at Jug City, onto County Road 9. Follow this road going west. After crossing the Noisy River, look carefully for the next left turn (Sideroad 6) and take it up the steep hill to the parking lot. If you didn't turn and now see the Creemore Brewery Spring, you have gone too far.

The tract of land, now known as the Creemore Nature Reserve was originally owned by the Mingay Family. Hence it is known as the Mingay Tract and Trail. The TD Bank (Friends of the Environment Foundation) has donated to the trail system and has provided signage and trail markings.

There is a copy of this map at the Trailhead, with the three trails: red, yellow and blue marked with blazes along the route.

If one always takes the trail to the right, at the different trail overlaps, you will easily make it around the loop, without having to memorize the map.
